# School's Challenge Awards

2018 saw the first year of the Royal Berkshire School's Challenge Awards. Children and their parents gathered for an early evening ceremony at Green Park where children collected trophy's for individual efforts, and combined efforts on behalf of their schools. The Mayor of Reading, X Factors Danyl Johnson and representatives from Green Park, Launchpad Reading, Dingleys Promise and Dingley Bear were all on hand to meet children and their families, and award prizes.

The 2019 School's Challenge Awards will take place on Tuesday 4th June. Children and their parents will be invited to attend should they win an individual trophy, or if their efforts have contributed towards a School Award. Children of any age can run in either race. However, to **qualify for entry in to the School's Challenge children must be the correct age on race day according to the race entered:**

Mini Mile - 4 to 8 years

3k Mini Marathon - 9 to 14 years

*Individual awards are made to the top 3 boys and girls in the Mini Mile for age groups 4/5, 5/6 and 7/8 years, and in the Mini Marathon for 9/10, 11/12 and 13/14 years. There are also school awards made in each age group using combined results from the schools top 3 runners.*
